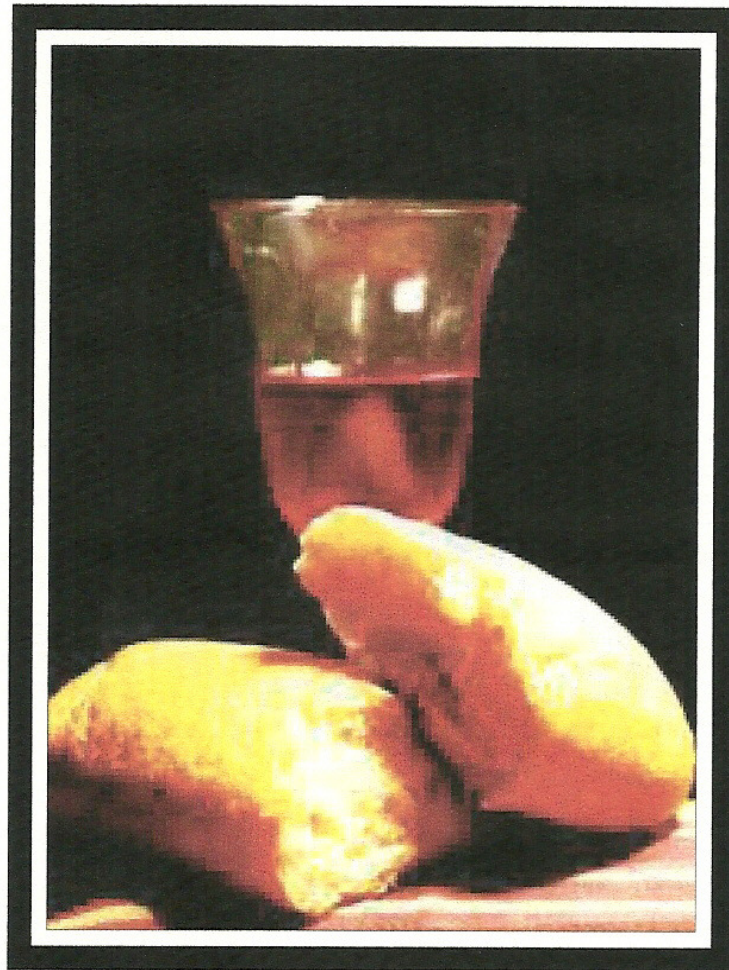

L: Come into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise.

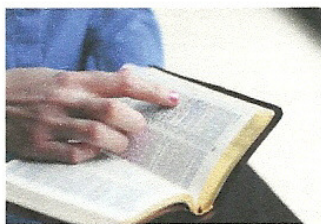
