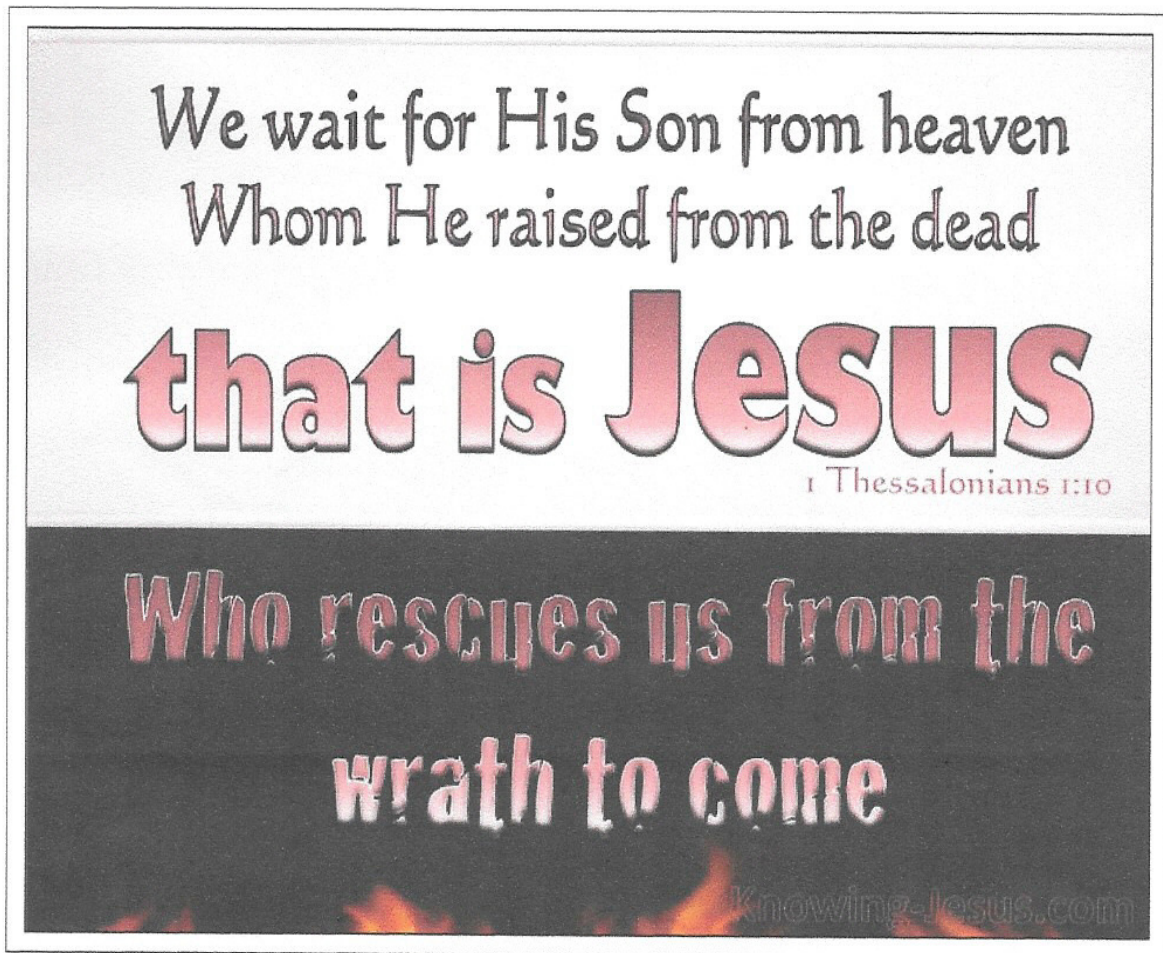

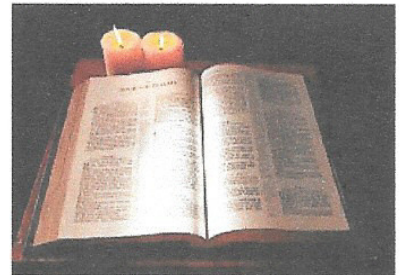
† **CALL TO WORSHIP OUR PRAYER OF INVOCATION** *Sourcebook*
