LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT CANDLES

The four candles on an Advent wreath represent the 4,000 years between Adam and Eve and the birth of Christ during which mankind waited for the arrival of Jesus. Each of the 4 candles represent 1,000 years. Those 4 candles are placed on a wreath of evergreen, which is shaped in a perfect circle to symbolize the eternity of GOD. In our church, three purple candles, one pink representing each week in Advent are used with one larger white candle in the middle as the Christ Candle, signifying perfect LOVE. A candle on the wreath is lit each Sunday during the season of Advent to signify the entrance of Christ, the light, into the world.
